There he committed himself to obedience; he accepted everything that the Lord would send him, and everything that men would want to put on his shoulders, carefully and humbly, for the sake of God. He crushed his willfulness; he committed himself through the people unto God’s will until the end; and he went into the forest, into the wilderness, so that nothing might separate him from God, but also so that nothing might serve him as an artificial prop, so that grace alone might strengthen his weakness, and faithfulness alone might serve him as a foothold.”
